a/k/a PATTI CAVANAUGH,


an employee of an Indian tribal organization, that is, Coordinator for Low Income Home
Energy Assistance Program of the Spirit Lake Tribe, Fort Totten, North Dakota, with
block grant funds allocated from the Department of Health and Human Services, a
federal agency, did knowingly and willfully embezzle, steal, and misapply property, that

is, moneys, funds, and credits belonging to said Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program of a value in excess of \$1,000;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1163.
