ORDER DENYING EX PARTE  
INTERIM ORDER

9 [ ] A petition for protective relief under the domestic violence chapter of N.D.C.C.  
10 Chapter 14-07.1

11 [X] A petition for a disorderly conduct restraining order under N.D.C.C. Chap. 12.1-31.2  
12 was filed on the 20th day of JULY, 2006. This court has reviewed this petition  
13 and for reasons set forth below concludes that it does not reach the appropriate level  
14 of evidence necessary to authorize the issuance of a emergency order. The reasons  
15 are: Most of the allegations are at best conclusory and  
16 not factually specific. The facts that are specified  
17 do not constitute acts of a disorderly nature and  
18 some are likely constitutionally protected.

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21 The petitioner may continue to move forward to prosecute this action but without an  
22 ex parte temporary order. The petitioner should advise the court of his or her intent  
23 to proceed or not to proceed forward with this action within 48 business hours. In the  
24 event that the petitioner does not advise the clerk of district court how he or she  
25 intends to proceed in this matter, it will be dismissed without prejudice.

His answer was, "She's a poor lady with no income she needed his help to get the cost of it waived." They were seen together at the court house. My sister is a social worker and saw them together there. She thought it was strange. Now I know why. Sharon is another one of those women like Dorothy Comer. She knows how to play the pitiful old woman. My daughter Patty worked construction with her and knows that this is no pitiful old lady. She struts around in a tank top, and short shorts with a cigarette dangling out of the corner of her mouth, flirting with construction workers they both worked for.

I was hoping this order would be of help to protect myself, but now I see I have to be worried and watch out for the Sheriff, the Clerk of Court, States Attorney Wang, and possibly the deputies. I believe now that they'll do anything to protect Pete and who ever else is on this city council.

Can I go above the county level to get a protective order or as an Indian is there any way I can get an order maybe through Tribal court or something?

I don't know much about such things this is all kind of new territory to me.
